What will we do? We'll worship, serve, eat and learn. Service-oriented ministry projects will be both inside and outside at Redeemer Covenant, with a quick field trip after lunch to a supermarket down the street for a cultural learning experience.

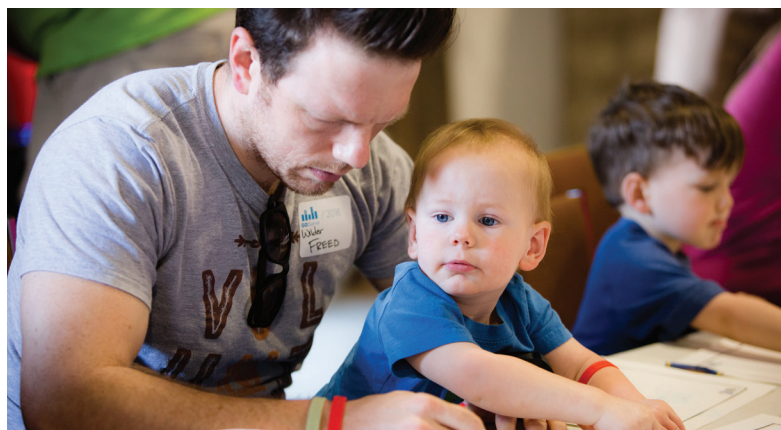

What about food allergies? We will not be handling food during the project portion of the day, and will have gluten-free options for lunch. Still have questions? Talk to us! We can most likely accommodate your needs with some advance notice.

How much driving will I do? Once you get yourselves to Redeemer, not much. For the market experience, we'll caravan in our vehicles to a large supermarket 5 minutes down the road. Both the church and the supermarket have parking lots, so you won't have to worry about street parking.

What should I bring? Lunch, snacks and water are provided. You'll want to wear comfortable clothing and bring a water bottle, if you'd like. Our outside activity may also involve water (think car wash, not swimming pool), so you may want a change of clothes or a towel. Bring a few extra dollars for the supermarket, an attitude of curiosity and a spirit of flexibility.

How many adults should we bring? All adults will be learning alongside the kids they came with, so bring whatever you think you need to keep track of each other and have a successful day.
