## SPEAKER: REV. DR. AL TIZON



Al Tizon is executive minister of Serve Globally, the international ministries arm of the ECC. This position includes a faculty appointment as affiliate professor of missional and global leadership at North Park Theological Seminary.

Al has engaged in community development, church leadership, advocacy, and urban ministry in the United States and in the Philippines.

Dr. Tizon will be challenging us with a global outlook under the title of “The ECC and God’s Whole Mission.” If possible, obtain a

copy of his book “Whole and Reconciled: Gospel, Church, and Mission in a Fractured World,” available in hard copy and Kindle on Amazon. We may be retirees, but God is still calling us to be global Christians through knowledge, reconciliation, and prayer.
