PURPOSE OF POSITION:

To minister to youth (6th - 12th grade) and their families within the broader ministry of First Covenant Church. JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:

Programming

- Plan and coordinate a cohesive, safe, age-appropriate ministry to youth and families (6th-12th grade), being mindful of the spiritual, social, cultural, educational, physical, and emotional differences of youth and their families in our community.
- Work in collaboration with the ministry team to ensure children and family ministries aligns with the broader mission and vision of the whole church.
- Ensure facilities, supplies and equipment for ministries are safe, welcoming, engaging, and age-appropriate.
- Lead the Confirmation Program along with the other pastors.
- Lead youth in other opportunities for spiritual growth and service both inside and outside the church (e.g. worship planning, Boundary Waters and summer trips, service learning opportunities, VBS)

Leadership and Vision

- Build relationships and serve as an advocate for youth and families within the church and those connected with First Covenant's ministries.
- Lead the Youth and Family Ministry Steering Team to plan and provide for long range goals and curriculum in alignment with First Covenant's mission and vision.
- Recruit, train, and motivate volunteers to serve in Youth and Family Ministries.
- Contribute to worship planning and implementing weekly worship services.
- Continue to grow in knowledge and expertise of Youth and Family Ministry to develop and maintain effective ministry skills.
- Assist and prepare youth for leadership roles through identification of their gifts, talents, and motivations.
- Collaborate with the ministry team to provide care and support for families in critical moments.

Communication and Administration

- Ensure consistent communication with youth, parents, volunteers, ministry team, congregation, and community.
- Develop, implement, communicate, and enforce appropriate policies and procedures for the safety of youth and families.
- Prepare and manage the annual Youth and Family Ministries budget.

Partnerships

- Collaborate with key community partners to provide relational ministries to youth and families in order to continue living into our mission and vision. Serve as key contact to McVay Youth Partnership.
- Engage with denominational partners that align with the vision and priorities of First Covenant Church. These may include, but are not limited to, Northwest Conference Youthworker Connection, and denominational NextGen Conference.

Other Areas of Responsibility

- Participate in designated FCC staff meetings, trainings, church-wide events, and initiatives that pertain to living out our mission together.
- Meet regularly with supervisor for prayer, planning, and accountability.
- Other duties as assigned; the responsibilities listed above are representative of the job and are not all-inclusive.

BASIC QUALIFICATIONS & EXPERIENCE:

Youth and Family Ministries:

- Clear sense of call to the faith development of youth
- A personal relationship with Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior and a commitment to continue attending to their own spiritual, physical, mental health, and relational needs with God, family, and friends.
- Commitment to First Covenant's <u>Identity, Mission, Vision, and Values</u> and <u>extending welcome</u> and inclusion to all people.
- 2+ years of paid youth ministry experience, or other relevant experience
- A commitment to minister to a diverse, urban community that seeks to be increasingly multi-ethnic and multi-generational with many socioeconomic backgrounds
- Experience with youth with special needs desired or a willingness to be trained in this area of ministry
- Ability to effectively plan, coordinate and carry out ministry events in a team environment
- Effective communicator, both verbally and in writing, with ministry team, parents, church members, and people in the community
- Excellent interpersonal skills
- Familiarity with and ability to use current technology and social media

ADDITIONAL PREFERRED KNOWLEDGE, GIFTS, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES:

- Bachelor's degree in youth ministry or a related field
- Strong aptitude for process improvement, problem solving, and creativity
- Ability to be flexible and respond/adapt to changing priorities
- Demonstrated learner within the fields of spiritual formation and leadership development
- Excellent relationship-building abilities
- Effective ability to recruit, retain, and develop both paid and volunteer staff
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills, especially listening and counseling, in a variety of cross-cultural contexts
- Ability to work effectively and efficiently, independently, as well as within a team structure
- Relatable and reliable
- Demonstrated ability to initiate and complete tasks and projects within a given timeline
