#### WHO //

Adventures in Leadership is for students completing grades 9-11 who demonstrate maturity, faith, and leadership potential. Participants should have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ and be endorsed by three adults who know them well: a pastor/youth leader, a teacher or coach, and a parent or guardian.

This experience is intentionally rigorous—physically, emotionally, and spiritually—helping young people develop resilience, faith, and confidence as they grow into Christ-centered leaders.

## WHY //

To provide an intentional experience that challenges students to depend on Christ, develop resilience, and gain practical skills for lifelong Christian leadership and service.
